## Poster Presentation

### - Application Guideline for Participants -

#### 1. Eligibility

The teams of Thai high school students in the science field who wish to make a poster presentation, other than the six finalists of KAGAYAKI AWARD 2024

#### 2. Number of participating teams

Up to 15 teams

#### 3. Language

Poster oral presentation: English

Q&A with the audiences: English in principle

#### 4. Entry Requirement

- Limited to teams that can participate and present at the venue (KX) on the day of the final evaluation (December 14 (Sat.))
- Each team must have no more than three members.
- Teams must apply for the KAGAYAKI AWARD 2024 and participate in the first screening. Participation only in the Poster Presentation is not allowed.

#### 5. Event Schedule

- Deadline for entry: August 19 (Mon.), 17:00 (ICT)
- Notification of first screening results: October 11 (Fri.)
- Gathering at the venue and setting up posters: December 14 (Sat.), 9:00-9:30(ICT)
- Poster oral presentation and voting: December 14 (Sat.), 11:30-12:30 (ICT)
- Awarding the Best Poster Award and participation certificates: December 14 (Sat.), 13:20-13:50 (ICT)
- Poster removal: December 14 (Sat.), 14:00~ (ICT)

## 6. Procedures for poster oral presentation

- The judges and audiences will go around the posters in turn, accordingly, please wait in front of each poster board.
- Please state the names of the team and high school, the research title, and the team members names at the beginning of the presentation.
- Each team will give a presentation of research summary within 3 minutes (strictly timed).
- The presentation may be shared among the team members or by some of the team members.
- A Q&A session with the judges and audiences will follow the presentation.

## 7. Participation Fees

Free of charge

Note 1: Participants are responsible for their own transportation expenses to the venue.

Note 2: Please print a poster by yourself and bring it on the day of the event.

## 8. Application Procedures and Deadline

- The teams who wish to participate in the Poster Presentation are required to register for both the KAGAYAKI AWARD 2024 and for the Poster Presentation.
